ST. MARY'S PRESCHOOL INFORMATION

- 1. St. Mary's Preschool will follow the NCCS/St. Mary's school schedule.**
- 2. Registration will be considered complete upon receipt of registration form, fee, and immunization records. If you wish to withdraw your child from Preschool, the registration and consumable fees will not be refunded.**
- 3. Children may brought to Preschool between 7:45 a.m. and 8:45 a.m. at a charge of \$1.50 per morning. Breakfast is available for \$1.00 at school until 8:30 a.m. Please bring your child to the Preschool room.**
- 4. You may pick up your child in the Preschool room at 11:30 a.m. or 3:00 pm for the afternoon session. There are times when emergencies arise. Please call the school as soon as possible if you will be late.**
- 5. If your child cannot attend school on a scheduled day, please notify the school at 298-3372 and leave a message for the preschool teacher.**
- 6. If someone other than the usual person is picking up your child, please let the preschool teacher know with a written note or phone call made by you.**
- 7. All preschool students are to be signed out, for security reasons.**
- 8. Please do not send your child to school if he/she has been running a fever, vomiting, or showing signs of illness.**
- 9. Please label all personal items that your child brings into the classroom. However, toys from home are discouraged. We are not responsible for any toys that are brought into the classroom. Toys that promote violence or violent play of any kind are not allowed in the classroom.**
- 10. Parents are asked to take turns bringing in a snack for their child's class.**
- 11. It is a prerequisite that your child be toilet trained and able to care for his/her needs (under ordinary circumstances) in the bathroom by September when he/she comes to Preschool.**

New York State Immunization Requirements for School Entrance into Pre-School

3 doses Diphtheria Toxoid Containing Vaccine (DtaP,DTP)

3 doses Polio injectable, oral (IPV,OPV) or combination

1 dose Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)

3 doses Hepatitis B

**3 doses Haemophilus influenzae type B
(HIB) OR**

1 dose on or after 15 months of age

1 dose Varicella (chicken pox) born on or after 01/01/2000
